



Addressing FAQs about International Delivery of the CPA Examination

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Overall Concept

- **Use the state-based licensure process to drive increased licensure rates**
 - Market and communicate value to candidates, employers, and consumers
 - Candidates sign “informed consent” including commitment to obtain license
 - Central database of all international licensees
 - Scores “archived” or made inactive if license not achieved or maintained
- **Terms: Extend the current NASBA – AICPA – Prometric agreement to include international administration**

Logistics

- **May 1st** **Registration began**
- **August 1st** **International administration will launch**
- **The CPA Exam will be administered at Prometric test centers**

 - Japan
 - Kuwait
 - Lebanon
